- Support the continuous professional development of Practitioners through reflective practice and learning
- Develop methods, service approaches, models, resources and tools needed to deliver activities within each service family
- Embed underlying values - participation, diversity, and safeguarding - in day-to-day practice
- Work alongside and in partnership with children and young people's groups identifying and acting upon important aspects and issues highlighted by them
- Inform and be informed by developments in policy, research, and campaigns and by changes in strategic direction
- Capture and use learning and knowledge to help enable positive changes in direct practice, systems and public attitudes
- To share success and best practice.
